REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

To help you prepare for the baptism of your child/children, you are asked to complete:

- ✓ Baptism Registration Form
- ✓ Baptism Godparent Eligibility Form

After <u>all the forms</u> are completed please <u>call the Parish Office</u> to schedule an appointment with a priest or deacon to review the baptismal forms.

<u>The dates</u> for the <u>baptism instructions</u> and <u>baptism</u> will be scheduled <u>only</u> after all completed forms and required documents are returned and reviewed by a priest or deacon.

To be admitted to the role of **Godparent/Sponsor**, a person <u>must</u>:

- ✓ Be a **Catholic** who has received the sacraments of **Baptism**, **Holy Communion** and **Confirmation**
- ✓ Have completed their 16th year of age
- ✓ Lead a life in harmony with the Catholic faith
- ✓ Be designated by the parents of the child
- ✓ Not be the father or the mother of the one to be baptized

It is permissible to have **only one Godparent** (a Catholic) as a sponsor for the baptism. If two Godparents are chosen, one of each sex must be employed.

<u>A Christian Witness</u> - a Christian who was baptized in a non-Catholic Church may be admitted as a witness to baptism together with a Catholic Godparent.

<u>Civil Record of Birth:</u> Parents who are <u>not married</u> are required to present a copy of the Civil Record of Birth to establish parental responsibility which will be retained by the rectory.

The suggested baptismal offering to the Saint William's Church is \$50.00.

If a **private Baptism** is requested, the date, time and celebrant will be determined by the pastor.
